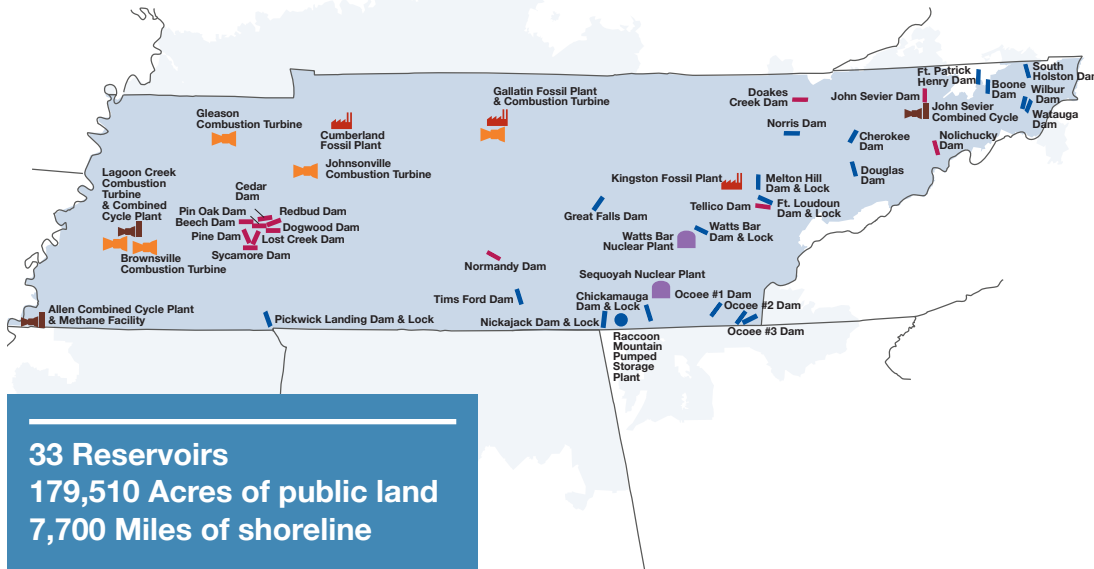


Our Impact

We proudly serve the people and communities of Tennessee by supplying energy for **7,022,772 people** through **85 local power companies** and for **25 large, direct-served customers** in the state. Reliable, affordable, clean energy from TVA helps **Tennesseans** across more than **42,000 square miles** stay connected, save money and get ahead. Our work is having an impact:



TVA assets in the state

- 19 hydroelectric dams
- 13 non-power dams
- 3 coal-fired plants
- 2 nuclear plants
- 8 natural gas-fueled facilities
- 1 pumped-storage hydroelectric plant
- 290 substations & switchyards
- 9,429 miles of transmission line

TVA has contracted for over 2,100 MW of renewable biomass, hydro, solar, and wind capacity in Tennessee

We partner with **153 local power companies** to serve **10 million people** and about **800,000 businesses** in the **seven-state Tennessee Valley region**, including parts of Alabama, Georgia, Kentucky, Mississippi, North Carolina, Tennessee and Virginia. We serve the people of the region by providing **affordable, reliable energy**; caring for **natural resources**, and **bringing good jobs to local communities**. 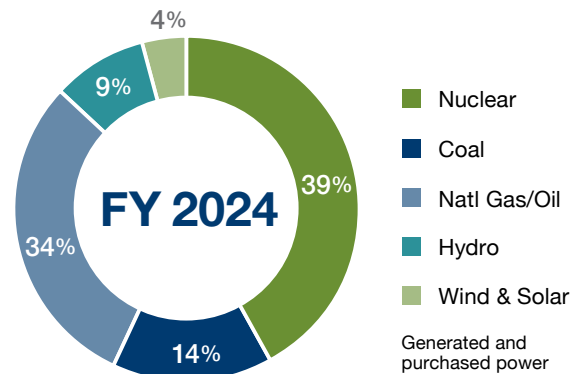
