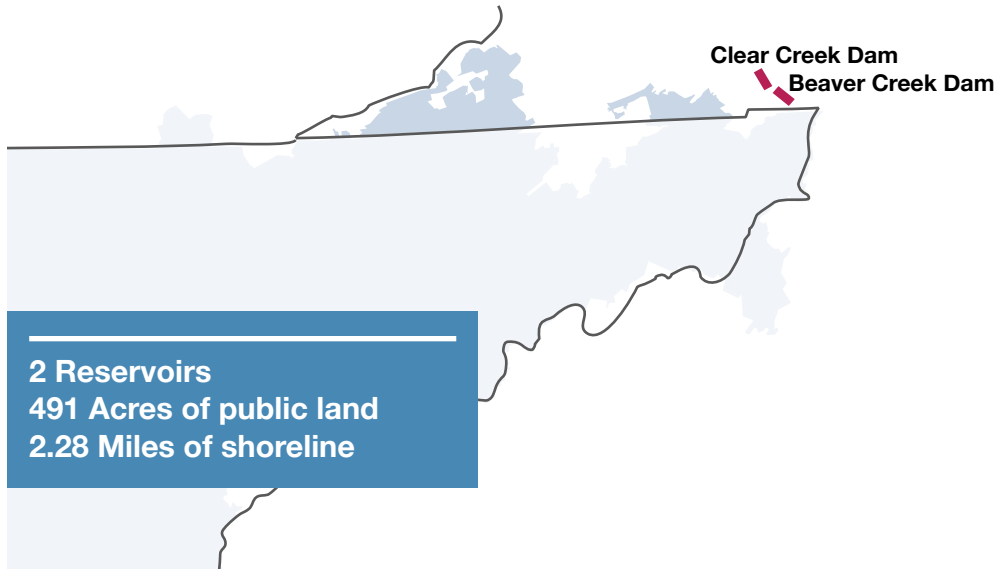


## Our Impact

We proudly serve the people and communities of **Virginia** by supplying energy for **44,812 people** through their two local power companies in the commonwealth. Reliable, affordable, clean energy from TVA helps Virginians **across more than 3,100 square miles** stay connected, save money and get ahead. Our work is having an impact:



### TVA assets in the state

- 2 non-power dams
- 1 substation/switchyard
- 11 miles of transmission line

TVA manages the Beaver Creek and Clear Creek reservoirs, in addition to the upper half of South Holston Reservoir that extends into Virginia

TVA has contracted for 1.6 MW of renewable biomass and solar capacity in Virginia

## Saving Virginians money and energy

**4 Businesses** Made more energy efficient through TVA Business Uplifts or energy efficiency services in FY 2023-2024

**\$81,000** Estimated savings by these businesses over the life of their energy improvements

**\$1,295** Incentives paid in FY 2024 to five businesses agreeing to shift energy use to off-peak hours, helping reduce peak demand

TVA serves Lee, Scott and Washington counties and a small portion of Wise County in Virginia. The Beaver Creek and Clear Creek projects provide flood protection and recreational opportunities to nearby communities in Virginia and Tennessee.

TVA is the nation's largest public power provider, delivering essential services to the people of the Valley region since 1933. We partner with **153 local power companies** to serve **10 million people** and about **800,000 businesses** in the **seven-state Tennessee Valley region**, including parts of Alabama, Georgia, Kentucky, Mississippi, North Carolina, Tennessee and Virginia. We serve the people of the region by providing **affordable, reliable energy**; caring for **natural resources**, and **bringing good jobs to local communities**. Our region's energy needs are growing, and TVA is focused on ensuring our region has a secure, **American-made energy future**.

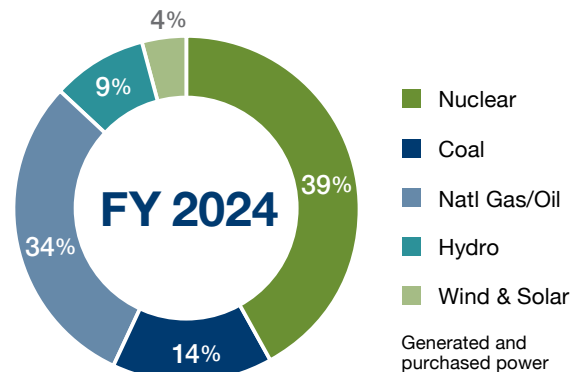
