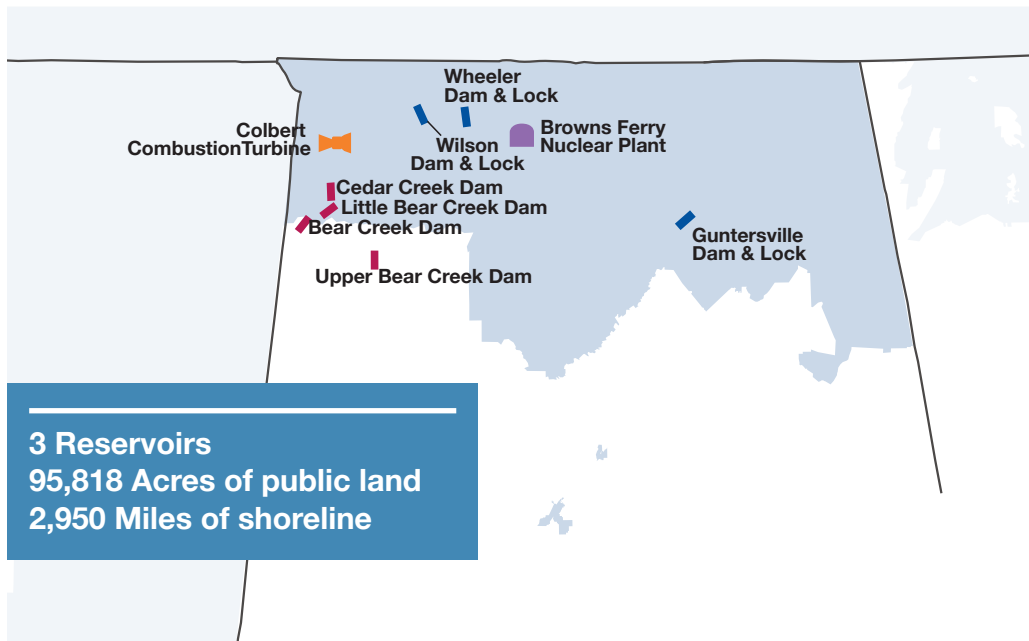


## Our Impact

We proudly serve the people and communities of **Alabama** by supplying energy for more than **1,241,172 people** through their **25 local power companies** and for **11 large, direct-served customers** in the state. Reliable, affordable, clean energy from TVA helps Alabamians **across nearly 9,000 square miles** stay connected, save money and get ahead. Our work is having an impact:



### TVA assets in the state

- 3 hydroelectric dams
- 4 non-power dams
- 1 nuclear plant
- 1 natural gas-fueled facility
- 90 substations & switchyards
- 2,410 miles of transmission line

TVA has contracted for nearly 340 MW of renewable biomass and solar capacity in Alabama

## Saving Alabamians money and energy

- 983 Homes** Made more energy efficient through TVA Home Uplifts and energy efficiency services
- \$1.1 Million** Estimated savings by these households over the life of their energy improvements
- 118 Businesses** Made more energy efficient through TVA Business Uplifts or energy efficiency services
- \$7 Million** Estimated savings by these businesses over the life of their energy improvements
- 7 Schools** Made more energy efficient through TVA School Uplifts or energy efficiency services
- \$86,127** Estimated savings by these schools over the lifetime of their energy improvements
- \$21.4 Million** Incentives paid in FY 2023 to 190 businesses agreeing to shift energy use to off-peak hours, helping reduce peak demand

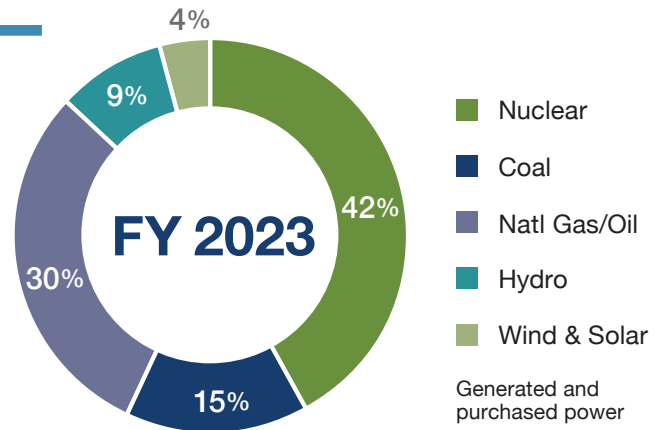
