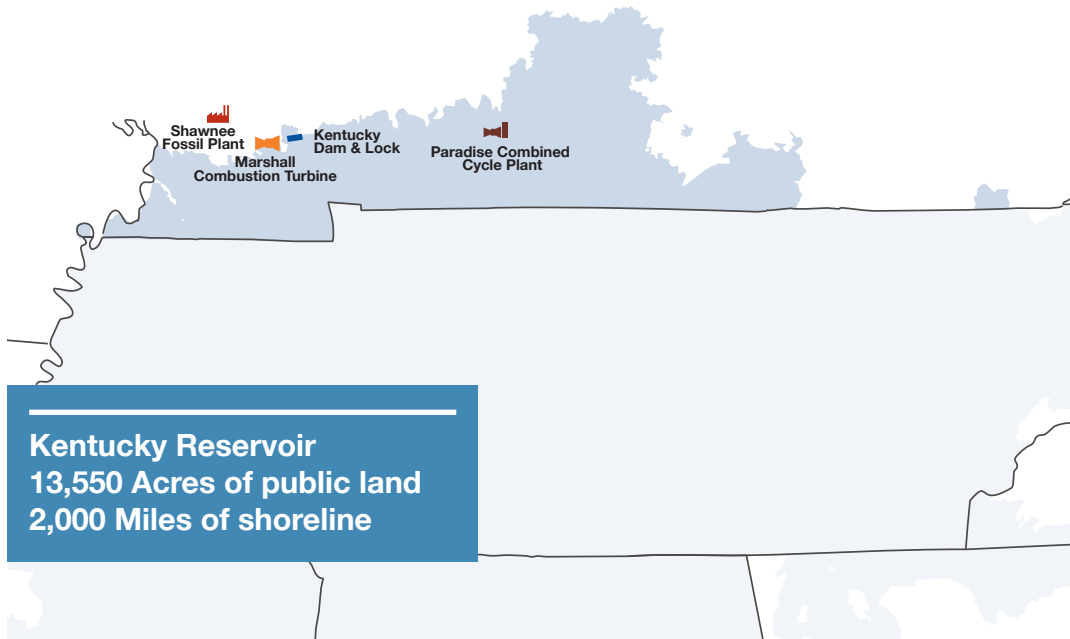


Our Impact

We proudly serve the people and communities of **Kentucky** by supplying energy for **516,996 people** through **16 local power companies** and for **14 large, direct-served customers** in the commonwealth. Reliable, affordable, clean energy from TVA helps Kentuckians **across nearly 7,800 square miles** stay connected, save money and get ahead. Our work is having an impact:



TVA assets in the state

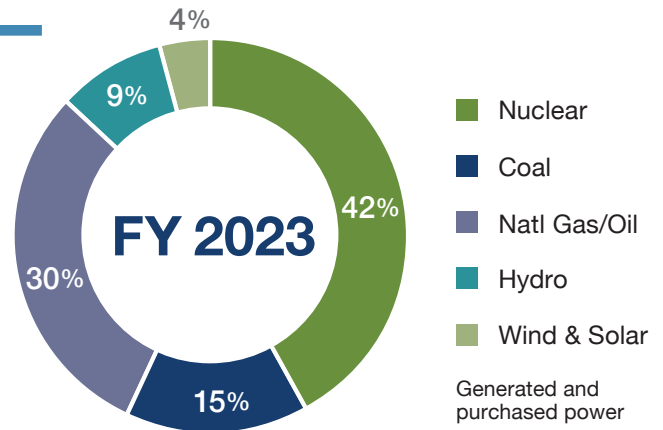
