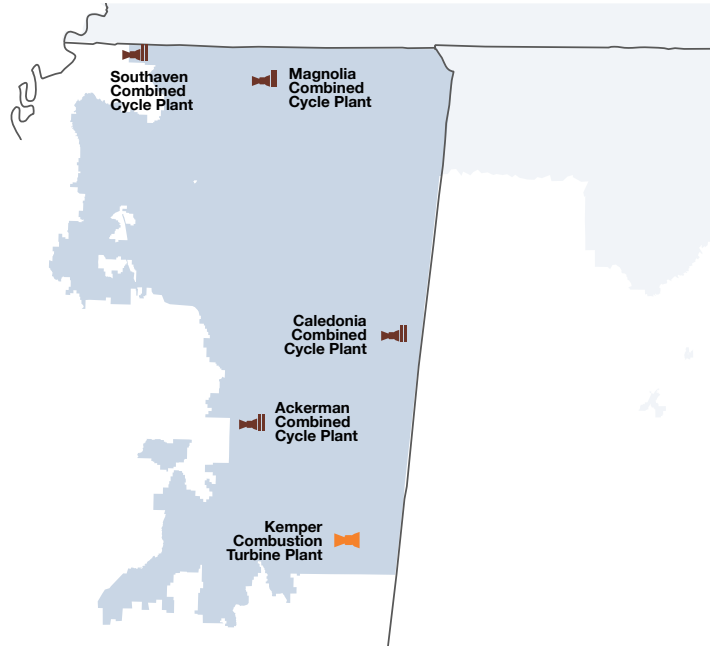


## Our Impact

We proudly serve the people and communities of **Mississippi** by supplying energy for **about 930,000 people** through their **28 local power companies** and for **eight large, directly served customers** in the state. Reliable, affordable, clean energy from TVA helps Mississippians **across almost 15,600 square miles** stay connected, save money and get ahead. Our work is having an impact:

TVA is the nation's largest public power provider, delivering essential services to the people of the Valley region since 1933. We partner with **153 local power companies** to serve more than **10 million people** and about **800,000 businesses** in the **seven-state Tennessee Valley region**, including parts of Alabama, Georgia, Kentucky, Mississippi, North Carolina, Tennessee and Virginia. We serve the people of the region by providing **affordable, reliable energy**; caring for **natural resources**; and **bringing good jobs to local communities**. Our region's energy needs are growing, and TVA is focused on ensuring our region has a secure **energy future**.

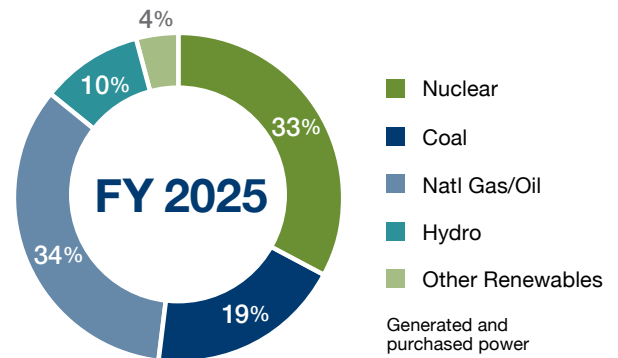
