2015 Integrated Resource
Plan – No new baseload
needed for the next 20 years.

Public comment period ended March 18

Comments posted April 21





Next steps include:

- Seeking a Board decision
- Any sale would be conducted through a public auction open to only qualified bidders.
- The extensive environmental review record for use of the BLN site may have to be supplemented and this likely would involve additional public input.
