Background

- TVA promoted recreation opportunities in the Tennessee Valley
- Increased tourism and enhanced economic opportunities
- TVA has worked with City, County, State, and Federal partners
- TVA partnered for maintenance and security of developed recreation areas
- TVA has provided technical expertise and limited funding to partners



Current Conditions

- TVA land transferred or under agreement to partners for public recreation use in the Tennessee Valley:
 - Federal Partners 348,000 acres
 - State Partners 120,000 acres
 - County Partners 4,000 acres
 - City Partners 3,600 acres
- These partnerships help support the estimated \$20 billion per year in visitor spending from water-related recreation
- Recent recession has impacted funding availability from all partners
- Tennessee Valley Region's "World Class" recreation venues:
 - Appalachian Trail
 - Ocoee River Whitewater
 - Guntersville Bass Fishery
 - South Holston Tailwater Trout






