





Stocking History

Stocking Year	Number
2013 proposed	26,000
2012	34,315
2011*	39,520
2010*	42,364
2009	27,547

^{*}Includes fall stockings to rebuild fishery

Trout Program Description

3 state trout hatcheries produce:

- 930,000 nine inch trout
- 760,000 three inch fingerling trout
- 355,000 lbs of nine inch trout
- **Chattahoochee National Fish Hatchery**
- Mitigation stockings for Blue Ridge, Lanier and Hartwell reservoirs

Economics of trout fishing

- 2009 study shows that 59% of anglers travel >30 miles to fish the Toccoa River.
- 25% of anglers are from metro Atlanta.
- 11% of anglers are from out of state (TN, FL & NC).

Basis for Federal Responsibility

- Federal Government has stocked this tailwater since 1976 as mitigation for impact of federal project on tailwater habitat.
- Office of Management and Budget has directed Fish & Wildlife Service to seek compensation for mitigation stockings.
- State sees stocking as a Federal Responsibility.
