## SOUTHEAST REGION FISHERIES PROGRAM BRIEFING

- Service Mission: Working with others to conserve, protect, and enhance fish, wildlife, and plants, and their habitats for the continuing benefit of the American people.
- \*\* Fisheries Program Mission: Working with partners to restore and maintain fish and other aquatic resources at self-sustaining levels and to support Federal mitigation programs for the benefit of the American public.



- \*\* No specific statutory obligations or court action ordering the Service to produce and stock trout.
- \* Congress directed the Service to perform mitigation when the hatcheries were originally constructed.
- \*\* The Service has been funded by Congress since 1965 to produce and stock over 1 million fish annually to mitigate the impacts of 14 different TVA water development projects in the Southeast Region.



- \* Six coldwater hatcheries
  - One broodstock hatchery
- \* Seven warmwater hatcheries
- Regional Fisheries Center
  - One warmwater hatchery
  - Fish Health Center
  - Fish Technology Center
- \* Two warmwater hatcheries currently off-line
- \* Eight Fish & Wildlife Conservation Offices



## \* Dale Hollow NFH, Celina, TN


- Opened 1966
- Original mission: mitigate impacts of Federal water development projects in TN & KY
- 60% of Facility's production for TVA
- 944,000 fish; 180,700 lbs.

## \* Chattahoochee Forest NFH, Suches, GA

- Opened 1939
- Original mission: restore and enhance recreational fisheries within Chattahoochee National Forest
- 7% of Facility's production for TVA
- 77,560 fish; 8,400 lbs.



- # Erwin NFH, Erwin, TN
  - Opened 1897
  - Original mission: produce trout and other fish species for TN waters
  - 978,000 eggs for TVA-related production
  - 1,100 fish, 100 lbs. (trophy fish)
- \* Warm Springs Fish Health Center, GA
  - Provides disease diagnostics



- Supports over 444,000 angler days
- \* Major economic driver in local, state, and regional economies
- \* Total Economic Output = \$45 million
- ★ Jobs generated = 504
- \* Wage and Salary Income = \$13 million
- Each \$1 of trout hatchery expenditures in the Southeast is associated with \$72.95 in economic output.

- \*\* Dale Hollow NFH also provides TN with 100,000 lbs. (~300,000 trout) under a contract




\* Rainbow Trout 76%

\*\* Brown Trout 17%

\*\* Brook Trout 4%

\* Lake Trout 3%

\*\* Trout stocked because native warm and cool water fish like smallmouth bass and largemouth bass were eliminated by cold water discharges from reservoirs



- \*\* Service has been directed to seek full cost reimbursement for the operation and maintenance of these facilities.
- \* Driven by:
  - Office of Management & Budget Directives
  - Congressional Directives
  - Budget Shortfalls
  - New Agency Priorities



- \* The Service has existing reimbursable agreements with:
  - •U.S. Army Corps of Engineers
    - (providing reimbursement since FY 2010)
  - ·Bureau of Reclamation
  - Bonneville Power Administration



- \* TVA will provide funding for production and stocking for the next 3 fiscal years
- Service is committed to working with TVA, TWRA, GA DNR, and others to develop a long-term permanent source of funding
- Service will only continue this important work as long as it is fully reimbursed
