Boone Reservoir Fishery Habitat Enhancement Project

Because of the extended drawdown period planned on Boone Reservoir, there may be public concerns about maintaining good fish populations within the reservoir. The Tennessee Wildlife Resource Agency (TWRA) and TVA will be partnering to insure that fish habitat on the reservoir remains good, which will lessen the impact of the extended drawdown. Both agencies will be implementing various activities to insure availability of suitable habitat during the drawdown period.
