**Solution for Boone Dam Earthen Embankment Seepage and Erosion to be Discussed at Public Meeting July 30**

Representatives from TVA will discuss the repairs necessary to stop the seepage and erosion taking place at the Boone Dam earthen embankment. The meeting will be held Thursday, July 30 at the Millennium Centre, located at 2001 Millennium Place in Johnson City, Tenn. Doors will open at 5 p.m. with the formal presentation beginning at 5:30 p.m. There will be an opportunity for the public to ask questions.

**TVA Opens Refurbished Visitor Centers at Fort Patrick Henry and South Holston Dams**
