



State Profile: Alabama, USA

Export leader

Exporting was a \$15.5 billion industry in Alabama in 2010, with manufactured goods from the state being shipped to 191 foreign destinations – a strong increase of 25.5% from 2009. The top five destination markets included Canada, China, Germany, Mexico and Brazil. Transportation equipment, chemicals, minerals, forestry products, and machinery accounted for 73% of Alabama's total shipments abroad in 2010.


Canada remained Alabama's top export destination for 2010. A total of \$3.2 billion of goods were shipped which included vehicles and parts, electric and industrial machinery, rubber products and paper.

Alabama's deepwater seaport terminals located at the Port of Mobile to the state's inland Port of Huntsville provides quality multi-modal transportation services for two-way trade.

Home to some 2,700 companies doing business internationally, Alabama is a better place to build a better world.
