Clifton was selected for the Tennessee Riverline/Rivertown program in October of 2020 and one of the program's initiatives is providing greater public access to the TN River. Our initial project is to extend the old ferry road (paved) and form a loop one block over and up to the intersection of Hwy 128 and Polk St. This will provide greater vehicle access to our boat dock and for the parking spots only; boat launch and recovery is strictly prohibited. This will also shore up an area that has been eroding from recent spring floods that is now only 40' from the major road at the top of the hill, Hwy 128. We also need to move our boat dock to an area that is in front of the proposed parking area and relocated to a swell that is just outside of the direct current of the river. We lost the dock in the 2019 flood and need a more secure location from future flooding and floating debris that constantly collects on the upriver side of the dock and gangway.
