National Trails Day Contest Scavenger Hunt Official Rules

Eligibility

The National Trails Day Scavenger Hunt (the "Contest") is open only to legal residents of Alabama, Georgia, Kentucky, Mississippi, North Carolina, Tennessee and Virginia, who are 18 (except 19 in Alabama and 21 in Mississippi) years of age or older as of date of entry and are served by a local power company that is served by the Tennessee Valley Authority (TVA). Employees, officers and directors of TVA ("Sponsor") and the power companies served by TVA, their immediate families (parent, child, sibling & spouse and their respective spouses, regardless of where they reside) and persons living in the same households as such individuals (whether related or not) are not eligible to participate in the Contest. By participating, you agree to these Official Rules and to the decisions of the Sponsor, which are final and binding in all respects. Void in any state not listed above and where prohibited by law, rule or regulation. All federal, state and local laws and regulations apply.

How to Enter

There is no purchase necessary to enter. There is one (1) way to enter the Contest:

Entrants must visit one or more of the 20 trails identified by the Sponsor at <u>https://www.tva.com/environment/recreation/tva-fun/celebrate-national-trails-day-with-tva</u>, which are located within the Sponsor's five service regions. Entrants will submit via email at least one photo of themselves with one or more of the provided scavenger items on the trail.

Contest Period

The Contest begins on May 6, 2024, at 1:00 a.m. in the Eastern Time Zone and ends June 2, 2024, at 12:59 a.m. in the Eastern Time Zone. Entries that are submitted before or after the Contest Period will be disqualified. Submission will be accepted for the duration of the Contest using the following method:

Prize Drawing

The Sponsor will select a winner in a random drawing from among all eligible entries received. A random number drawn from a bag will be selected by Contest organizers and applied to the order of submitted entries, i.e., if 17 is the number drawn, then the 17th eligible Contest submission received, will be named the winner. On or about June 7, the Sponsor will attempt to notify the potential winner via email. If the potential winner cannot be contacted within five days after the date of first attempt to contact them, the Sponsor may select an alternate potential winner at random from the remaining non-winning eligible entries.

Prizes

There is a limit of only one prize package per randomly selected winner during the entry period. The prize package will consist of a (i) tent, (ii) sleeping bag, and (iii) Sponsor's choosing of Trails Day swag.

Approximate Retail Value ("ARV") of Contest Prize is \$520. Prizes will be awarded only upon winner redemption, confirmation, verification and final approval by Sponsor.
