



New TVA report details efforts to empower sustainable communities

The FY 2021 Sustainability Report shares agency's innovative, integrated approach to sustainability and stimulating a clean energy economy across the region.

TVA's mission has remained constant since our inception and goes beyond generating power. Sustainability at TVA encompasses:

Economic Impact: Powering to build the region's clean energy economy

Environmental: Stewarding the region's resources

Social: Serving people and communities across the region

Governance: Driving progress through accountability and transparency

Sustainability is deeply rooted in TVA's mission. We consider sustainability in everything we do — in the energy we provide, the natural resources we preserve, and the jobs and investments we attract to the region.

Our FY 2021 Sustainability Report highlights the innovative work we're doing today and the ways we're partnering with others to build a sustainable tomorrow.

What does sustainability look like to us? At TVA, we are:

- Advancing a variety of initiatives to move the needle toward our aspirational goal of net-zero carbon emissions by 2050 as we execute our plan to 70% carbon reduction by 2030
- Expanding renewable energy on our system – we grew solar 77% in FY 2021 alone and are targeting up to 10,000 megawatts of solar by 2035
- Partnering with local power companies and state agencies to accelerate the adoption of electric vehicles – collaborating to build a network of fast-charging stations, attracting electric vehicle and battery manufacturers, and unveiling our own commitment to electrify TVA's fleet
- Working with state and local partners to attract jobs and investment to our seven-state service area (more than 350,000 jobs and \$45.9 billion in capital investments over the past five years)
- Protecting and enhancing the region's natural resources through aggressive clean air control and waste management programs, proactive biodiversity policy, and afforestation efforts
- Offering programs to assist consumers in underserved communities and those struggling with high energy burden, providing relief during the COVID-19 pandemic and assisting in clean-up and rebuilding efforts after severe weather events
- Living our values – Safety, Integrity, Inclusion and Service – all fundamental beliefs that guide TVA actions, behaviors and decisions as a company
